P2 Mrs O'Neill's Class Assembly

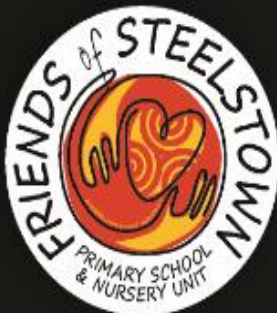
Well done to Mrs O'Neill's P2 Class on their beautiful assembly all about spring. It was great to have families join us. We are so proud of you all.
