



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
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Free School Meals

Credit Union Saving scheme Y3-Y7

This year Y3-Y7 children in Steelstown PS can participate in the Derry Credit Union's School Savings Scheme, CLASS!

This scheme teaches children the value of small, regular savings.

The scheme will permit children to save from 50p to £5 per week over three ten-week terms. Your child's money will returned in full at the end of the school year in June. While we encourage regular savings, children do not have to save every week and will be given an opportunity to catch up if they miss a week.

Credit Union Day each week is Tuesday.

The first savings will be collected on Tuesday, 27th of September for those children who have already signed
