
Our topic is Off We Go!!

- We will look at different types of transport. Try to see what vehicles you can see around Derry. Visit the library to look at books.
- We will compare transport now with transport from the past. Ask grandparents to discuss with your child how transport technology has changed over their lifetime. Look for pictures on the internet.
- We will look at what makes things move i.e., batteries, springs, wheels, and axles. Look at some of your child's own toys and discuss how they move.
- We will discuss holidays, destinations and how we get there. Discuss holidays you and your child have been on. Look at photographs.





Number

Continue to count to 100. Practise writing numbers to 50 correctly. Look for numbers all around. Continue to count in 2's, 5's and 10's. Try adding using near doubles e.g., 9+8= double 8 and 1 more. Continue to learn number stories to 10. Try to mentally add and subtract. Give your child oral problems to solve e.g., you have 10p and spend 6p. How much do you have left? Use words like: more, less, altogether and the difference between. Look at the clock and tell o'clock and half past times. Use analogue and digital time.



Using our Jolly Phonics, we have practised the 42 sounds and some of the diagraph variations, e.g., ai, a-e, ay, a.
